



Jumping Queensland Development Group Application Criteria for 2020



Jumping Queensland Development Group is focused on the future of our riders and young horses. The Group is available to horse and rider combinations to have access to the expert knowledge and coaching provided at the clinics.

There will be a minimum of 2 clinics per year available to horse and rider combinations at a reduced price.

Development Group Application Criteria:

All horse and riders must meet criteria and submit their application prior to 1 December 2019.

Eligible applicants must meet all the below criteria:

- Riders must be 16 years or older
- Horses cannot be on any of the Qld State Squads
- Horses must be 10 years of age or younger
- Horse and Rider combination must be consistently competing at 1.25m or higher
- Horse and Rider combination must be able to attend clinics provided (exemptions can apply)

Applications must include be submitted on the below application form.

Horse and Rider Selection:

12 Horse and Rider combinations will be selected by Jumping State Selectors on their performances over the previous 12 months.

General Selection Criteria for All Groups

The following general requirements apply to the group:

1. Athletes must be current financial members of Equestrian Queensland,
2. Owners of horses must be current financial members of Equestrian Queensland /Equestrian Australia
3. Horses that have qualified may only be selected with one athlete. In the event that more than one athlete competes a specific horse, the selected combination will be at the discretion of the Selection Panel and will be performance based.
5. Automatic exclusion from the group will apply to the following:
 - Sale of horse
 - horse no longer being ridden by qualified rider/horse combination
6. Automatic exclusion from the group will be updated immediately on the EQ website, additionally, it is the riders' responsibility to inform the EQ Sport Development Officer (High Performance) in writing in a timely fashion when horses are either sold or no longer being ridden by that rider.
7. Athletes must be Australian citizens or permanent residents,
8. Athletes with dual citizenship (one of which is Australian) must declare that they will ride for Australia and Queensland,

9. Results will be taken from the official Equestrian Australia results database and will also be independently verified.
10. Athlete selection and/or exclusion is subject to any yellow card, strict liability offence and/or medication control violations.
11. Athletes must conform to the EA Code of Conduct, EA Social Media Policy and Welfare of the Horse or be subject to disciplinary procedures.
12. Horses and athletes must be sound and fit to satisfy competition standards in 2019.
13. Athletes must notify EQ Sport Development Officer - High Performance as soon as possible of the sale of a group horse, any injury or illness to the horse and/or rider which may impede competition attendance. All correspondence will be confidential. (The EQ SDO – High Performance will in turn notify the Selection Panel).
