# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## ENTRIES

- All entries are to be made via Equipe
- **Entries open: 8pm Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2024**
- **Entries close: 8pm Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2024**
- A \$25 Ambulance levy and a \$25 administration fee will be charged per rider

### Wait List

- Wait lists will be created for classes if oversubscribed, and competitors will be notified of acceptance once nominations are finalised
- Entries will be accepted once your payment has been processed
- Equestrian Australia Waivers must be signed for your entry to be accepted – form on Equipe

### Number of Starts

- Maximum of two starts per horse for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> days
- ONE START ONLY on Monday
- A horse is able to compete in two different series but can only compete in one final (or championship), if qualified for more than one, competitor must let the office know which final the horse will compete in so that another horse can be given the opportunity to start in final in which the horse is being withdrawn.
- Each rider is permitted no more than 3 entries in one class

### Refunds

- Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$25 administration fee
- No refund after close of entries

## CAMPING & STABLE / YARD BOOKINGS

Camping and stable bookings are to be made online via Equipe.

## SCRATCHINGS

Notice of scratchings must be completed on Equipe.

## DRAWS / RESULTS

- Draws will be posted on Equipe and the events will run to draw order.
- Results will be live on Equipe.

# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## RULES & REGULATIONS

- This event is run under Equestrian Australia rules and regulations
- The Organising Committee reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend the program or any of the conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit
- All riders must wear helmets that comply with EA Helmet standards

### EA Membership and Horse Registration

- All riders and owners must be current financial members of Equestrian Australia (EA)
- An EQ Come and Try Membership is available at \$22 per junior rider or \$55 per senior rider for classes ONLY in the Pryde's EasiFeed Ring 3, 70cm—1m (horses must be EA base registered)
- Riders competing in 1.05m and above must have EA competitor membership and riders competing below 105m are required to have a participant or competitor membership
- All horses competing in 1.05m and above classes must be EA full life registered and have a current jumping competition licence.
- All horses competing below 1.05m must be EA base registered

### Presentations

Riders **MUST** present at presentation mounted (stallions may be substituted for presentation) or prizemoney will be forfeited

## CHAMPIONSHIPS & FINALS

- The top 30 placed horses for each Series will be selected via the following system:
  - The overall winner of a qualifying class will receive the same number of points as horses in the class e.g. If there are 50 horses in the class, the winner will receive 50 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 49 and so on down to 1 point for the last horse. If a horse and rider is eliminated or retires, no points are allocated
  - The points received in the two classes will be combined and the highest 30 scores will receive a place in the Final (or Championship) class
- The draw for the final will be the reverse of points gained e.g. the horse with the most points will go last in the draw for the final
- All qualifier rounds must be the same horse and rider combination, including the final

## CLASS ELIGIBILITY

- **Children:** An Athlete may compete in Children's classes from the calendar year they turn 10 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14 years old.
- **Juniors:** Athletes can take part in Competitions for Juniors from the calendar year they turn 12 until the end of the calendar year, in which they reach the age of 18 years
- **Young Riders:** Athletes may take part in Competitions and Championships for Young Riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 21.
- **Amateur Rider:** Athletes who:
  - Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing
  - In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying competition or in a 5\* 3 day event/ 4\* 3 day event prior to 2021.
  - Must not have competed in section 1 or 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years
  - Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that event.
  - Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a Horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that event



# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## BIOSECURITY, HEALTH & SAFETY

### Other Animals

- No animals other than competition horses are permitted in or around the stable, warm up or competition areas.
- All other animals must be restrained and kept within the camping area.
- There is a full fenced off leash dog park located at the southern end of the campground.

### Scooters and Bikes

- Not to be used in or near any competition or warm up areas or stable areas
- Helmets must be worn
- Any scooter or bike that is left unattended will be confiscated

### Prams, strollers and the protection of young children

- There are to be no prams, strollers or young children in any warm up areas during the competition.

### Horse Health Declarations

- Horse Health Declarations (HHD) must be supplied on arrival or emailed prior to competing.
