Hendra Vaccination

THIS IS A HENDRA VACCINATED EVENT if you are from a High-Risk Hendra Area, if you are from a low-risk area, please apply for an exemption to compete (HORSES BASED SOUTH OF SYDNEY). Hendra Vaccine Boosters must have been administered within the previous 18 months OR

- The first of the two initial vaccines must have been administered before the event.
- Exemptions may be considered and should be applied for via tamborineequestriangroup@outlook.com (please note that horses that have never had a vaccine will not be considered for an exemption.)
- Microchip numbers must be provided with entry.
- The committee reserves the right to conduct random checks of Hendra vaccination compliance throughout the weekend.
- Hendra Vaccination does not replace good biosecurity practice, and a horse health declaration must still be presented on arrival to the event

- Riders in all classes must be current financial EA members.
- Horses in EvA95 and above must have current EA registration.
- Horses and Riders in International FEI Classes must have relevant and current registrations, documents and passports
- Under the EA competition rules, this event may be selected randomly for the Medication Control **Program (Swabbing)**
- Members should ensure that when attending activities, their EA Horse registration documentation should be available for the MCP Steward if their horses are either base registered or life registered.

- DAILY SCHEDULE will be published before the event
- The event classes 1 through 13 will be conducted under Equestrian Australia National Eventing Rules/FEI rules.
- Free Base Registration for all other horses is available on the EQ website.
- Substitutions of horse and rider will be accepted up until 23 September 2024 if it is within the same class. No other substitutions will be considered.
- Medical Coverage at this event will be in accordance with the required level as specified in the Equestrian Australia National Eventing Rules, EA Annex D.1 CCN Medical and Veterinary Services, a copy of this document is located online at: https://equestrian.org.au/eventing-rules
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they hold the necessary MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY **REQUIREMENTS** to enter their desired class. EA rule 517-522.
- EvQ Classes will be limited to 40 Horse & Rider combinations.
- Should nominations exceed this number a waitlist will be used to fill scratching's as they are known.
- Should Entries be sufficient/insufficient in classes 1-13, the class will be split in a manner deemed appropriate by the Organising Committee.
- Juniors will be recognised in combined classes

The Organiser reserves the right:

- The cross-country course must be walked on foot only.

A farrier will be on call for the duration of the event.

EA 515.2.7 CCN Objections

Only the owner, or his authorised agent, or the rider of a horse taking part in the competition is entitled to lodge an objection. Protests must be in writing, signed by the person making the protest, and presented personally to the Event Secretary or the Technical Delegate, as the case may be, together with any supporting evidence, names of witnesses and the necessary minimum deposit of \$50. Protests concerning the eligibility of an athlete or horse or to the conditions of the arena: not later than 30 minutes before the start of the relevant competition; Protests concerning an obstacle, or the plan or length of the course for a jumping competition: not later than 15 minutes before the start of the competition; Protests concerning the cross-country obstacles or courses in Eventing not later than 6pm on the day before the relevant competition; Protests concerning irregularities or incidents during a competition, or the classification of a competition: not later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results or the posting of results on the event notice board. Any person making a protest should, if possible, secure witnesses to the incident and any other form of evidence, and either bring them to the body before whom the protest is lodged, or obtain written statements from them, duly signed, together with their names and addresses.

HOUSE KEEPING

BIOSECURITY

ARRIVAL VET INSPECTION

For horses in the 3 Day Event classes and FEI Classes, the Arrival Inspection will be done on arrival to the grounds. Times will be advised closer to the time.

Horses and riders must have current 2024 FEI registrations and the relevant ID documents for their level of competition and fulfill the heath requirements through the FEI APP.
