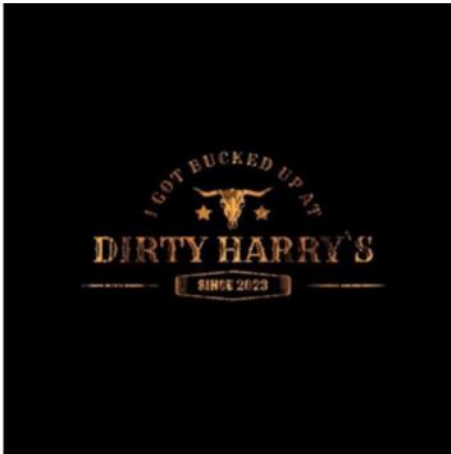
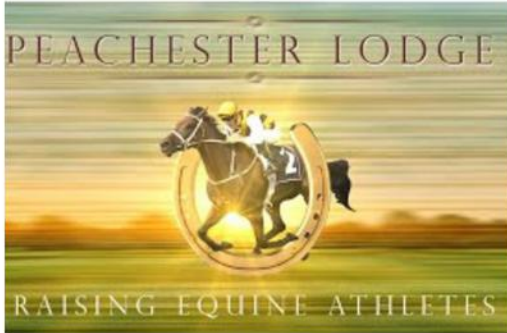

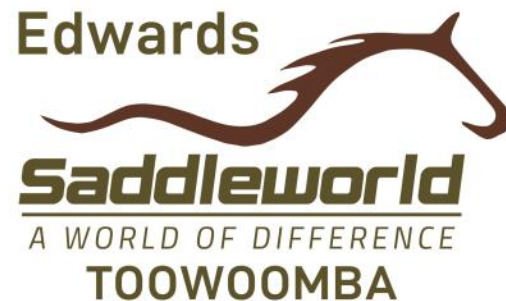

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All riders entering the event understand and accept the Conditions of Entry.

HEALTH DECLARATIONS must be completed on global when entering.

All rings both days are 7.00am course walk 7:30am start.

Horses are allowed 2 starts per day including championship classes.

Horses can only compete in one of the A and B classes, not both.

No HC starts in Championship classes.

Draws will be posted on Global. Riders are expected to adhere to draw order.

BEHAVIOUR

All competitors must obey EQ rules and competition etiquette, those who fail to do so risk elimination from the competition.

Damage to any third party by anyone at the competition will be held responsible for damages.

Yards are booked for duration of show \$30 per horse plus \$20 bond per horse.

Yards are checked and there will be no bond refund if left dirty.

Manure and hay must be picked up and placed in the signed manure area.

Dress shirts with collars, jodhpurs white or fawn with approved EA helmet and boots.

Classes noted as *Interschool Qualifiers* are open to everyone but may be used as qualifiers by Interschool riders.

Riders competing in official classes must be current EQ members.

Riders competing in unofficial classes must be EQ or DDSJC current members.

All horses must be registered with Equestrian Qld.

Horses competing in classes 1.00m or below must be EQ Base registered. Registration is free until May.

No refunds given after closing date. Scratchings before closing date will incur a \$15 admin fee.

Competitors are reminded that Medication Control (Swabbing can occur at any event run under Equestrian Australia rules and regulations).

Dogs are allowed on the grounds but must be on a lead at all times.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR INTERSCHOOL RIDERS

This event is being conducted under the rules as per the IQ Handbook 2024 and EQ and FEI Rules. It is your responsibility to read your Handbook and be aware of these rules. Riders/Horses must be registered with the Inter-School Queensland sport Committee.

IQ qualifiers are - 1 class per height may be used as a IQ qualifier.

Classes 1a, 1b, 2a, 2b, 3a and 3b in Ring 1 on Friday and Classes 5, 6, 7a, 7b, 8a and 8b on Saturday are all eligible as Interschool Queensland qualifiers.

All Interschool riders please enter **Class 18**.

INFORMATION FOR THE TSHA COMPETITOR

To be eligible for TSHA classes, your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book. No part bred thoroughbreds will be eligible.

To compete in the thoroughbred only classes, you must purchase a competition license with the TSHA through Global Entries Online. The license costs \$55 and runs for a calendar year from the date of purchase.

How do I obtain my license?

The license can be obtained by logging into www.globalentriesonline.com.au

- Go to the "Manage Horses" page
- Click on the "TSHA license" button and fill in the details
- If you don't already have an account with Global Entries, it is simple to create one and then follow the instructions above.

The microchip number is important. It does not matter whether the horse is EA registered with a different name so long as the description and microchip number match. If you are having trouble finding the information, please send us an email info@thoroughbredsporthorse.com.au and we can help you.

The license fee is for competition purposes only and is not proof of ownership. Any prize money will be paid to the winning rider. Connections of the horse must organize the prize money split, if any, between themselves. Any horses and riders competing in the TSHA Thoroughbred classes 1.05m and over must also hold EA registration.
