Entry Conditions Page 1

- Riders must be a member of Whitsunday Equestrian Group (WEG) or EA.
- This competition is to be run under 2024 EA rules. **No late** nominations will be accepted.
- Riders compete at their own risk neither the organising committee of any competition to which these rules apply nor the EA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- It is the responsibility of all riders to familiarise themselves with the current EA rules and compulsory dress
 regulations relating to competitions.
- The committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any event in the schedule at any time without notice.
- All dogs must be kept on a leash at your campsite at all times.
- Electric fences are not allowed.
- Stables must be left clean. A deposit of \$10 is required for use of stables. Riders will forfeit the refund of this
 deposit if stables are left with manure. If cleaned appropriately, this deposit will be refunded following the event.
- Stallions stabled in designated stables, green discs must be used at all times (riding/leading/stabled).
- Horse Health Declaration must be presented on arrival at the grounds.
- Hendra Vaccination Certificates are NOT compulsory for this event.
- Horses may compete in only 2 Show jumping Classes of the same height or consecutive height per day. Either the leaderboard event OR the corresponding class can be entered e.g. you can enter either Class 16 OR Class 16LB.
- Horse to be ridden by the same rider for the duration of the event.
- Closed Rest Classes open to registered/ unregistered horses but if registered, horses must be ridden at their correct grading level or HC. WEG members only, restricted membership available.
- Competitors must present themselves to the gear steward before their round. This is not a gear safety checkriders are responsible for the condition & safety of their own equipment.
- Only 2 riders permitted at a time in the show jumping warm-up area.

All riders are expected to assist with such duties as judge pencilling, setting up and pulling down of the show jumping course, and gear check. Volunteer rosters will be sent out with the draw to assist in the smooth running of this event. Riders can nominate another person (e.g. parent) to volunteer on their behalf by contacting us directly, and preferences made during nomination.



Entry Conditions Page 2

Dress Standard - minimum acceptable for all competitors

Current approved standard helmet must be worn. A helmet tag must be displayed to demonstrate a current standard of helmet.

Jodhpurs or breeches – Show jumping riders may wear any solid colour e.g. Black, grey, brown or navy but must be in good condition (no tears or faded).

Short or long sleeved shirt for all riders. Collars preferred but not essential. Jackets preferred for Grand Prix.
